Spring and Fall Semester Program: Come to Washington for 16 weeks, intern 32 hours a week, take classes on Fridays, and complete a major research project. Semester term students earn 15-16 credit hours at their home school. The course covers selected aspects of public policy and the policy-making process, as well as career and job tips. [Open to all majors.](#)

Summer Program: Come to Washington for eight weeks, intern full-time, take a night course, and earn 6 credit hours at your home school. [Open to all majors.](#)

Additional Information on costs: SUNY students pay tuition and their usual student fees at their home school plus a program fee to SUNY Brockport (\$975-\$1,375 in the fall and spring, \$314-\$514 in the summer). Non-SUNY students pay their regular home school tuition. In addition, meals, housing, and transportation costs in Washington, D.C. average about \$6,700 for the fifteen-week spring session and about \$3,700 for the eight-week summer session.

Application deadlines: Spring Program—Nov. 30; Fall Program—May 30.

The application deadline for the Summer Program is April 15.

Earlier applications are strongly recommended.
